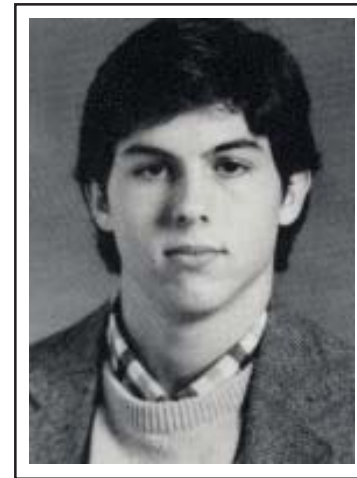

The 16th Annual John Stone Invitational Classic

The John Stone Invitational Classic honors the life of John Stone, Christchurch School class of 1986. When John initially came to Christchurch School from his home of Macon, GA, he had poor grades and a less-than-promising attitude. While at Christchurch, John flourished in our close-knit, small, 24-hour community. He seized the opportunity to turn his life around, and he became a standout student-athlete. John was an academic honor student, he served as a proctor and a member of the disciplinary committee, and he was selected by his peers and coaches to captain the basketball and lacrosse teams. John led the basketball team on a summer 1985 tour of Europe and to the 1985-86 independent school state finals. It was John Stone #33 who stepped forward in the closing seconds of the state tournament semi-finals to hit a jumper that moved Christchurch into overtime and on to the finals.

At Hampden-Sydney College John prospered, performed well academically, pledged a fraternity, and was a member of the lacrosse team. John died following an automobile accident in September of 1988.

John is remembered by those who knew him as “a great kid and a wonderful human being, ” a true Seahorse.
